THIS is to certify that the TOWN OF HEMPSTEAD INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY has been established by special act of the New York State Legislature, and the following is set forth pursuant to Section 856 of the New York State Industrial Development Agency Act:

- (1) The special act establishing the Agency was passed June 17, 1971, by Chapter 529 of the Laws of 1971 which became effective June 17, 1971.
- (2) The name of the agency is: Town of Hempstead Industrial Development Agency.
- (3) The names of the members of the Agency and their chairman, all of whom shall serve at the pleasure of the Town Board of the Town of Hempstead, the governing body of the municipality for whose benefit subject Agency was established, are as follows:

(4) The facts establishing the need for such Agency in the municipality are as follows:

For the benefit of the town of Hempstead, county of Nassau, and the inhabitants thereof, an industrial development agency, to be known as the TOWN OF HEMPSTEAD INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY, is hereby established for the accomplishment of any or all of the purposes specified in title one of article eighteen-A of this chapter. It shall constitute a body corporate and politic, and be perpetual in duration. It shall have the powers and duties now or hereafter conferred by title one of article eighteen-A of this chapter upon industrial development agencies and provide that the exercise of the powers by such agency with respect to the acquisition of real property whether by purchase, condemnation or otherwise, shall be limited to the corporate limits of the town of Hempstead, and such agency shall take into consideration the local zoning and planning regulations as well as the regional and local comprehensive land use It shall be organized in a manner prescribed by and be subject to the provisions of title one of article eighteen-A of this chapter. Its members shall be appointed by the governing body of the town of Hempstead, county of Nassau. The agency, its members, officers and employees, and its operations and activities shall in all respects be governed by the provisions of title one of article eighteen-A of this chapter.

(CORPORATE SEAL)

The subject law became effective on June 17, 1971 upon signing of same into law by the Governor.

Section 856 of the General Municipal Law requires that the Town Board shall file within six months from the aforesaid June 17, 1971, a certificate in the office of the Secretary of State setting forth the following:

- 1. The date of passage of the special act establishing the agency;
 - 2. The name of the agency;
- 3. The names of the members and their terms of office, specifically which member is the chairman; and
- 4. The facts establishing the need for the establishment of an agency in such municipality.

Please be advised that Section 856 of the General Municipal Law provides that the agency shall consist of not less than three, nor more than five members to be appointed by the Town Board and who shall serve at the Town Board's pleasure.

Members continue to hold office until successors are appointed. The Town Board designates the first chairman and files with the Secretary of State a certificate of appointment. Members receive no compensation for services, but are entitled to necessary expenses, including traveling expenses, incurred in the discharge of their duties. Any one or more of the members may be an official or an employee of the Town without forfeiture of municipal office or employment. However, a member who is an employee or official of the Town will have his membership terminated at the expiration of his term of municipal office.

In n teen hundred sixty eight the Town of Hempstead created the Town of Hempstead Local Development Corporation. This local development corporation, which is one of the most successful in the State of New York, created the Town of Hempstead Industrial Park at Freeport, wherein twenty six industrial plants were established. This resulted in an increase of five hundred thousand dollars per year in real estate taxes, two thousand additional jobs and an annual payroll of fourteen million dollars.

A local development corporation is limited solely to assisting financially and otherwise the construction, acquisition, rehabilitation and improvement of only industrial or manufacturing plants. An industrial development agency has much broader powers in that it is authorized to promote, develop and encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of warehousing, commercial and research facilities, in addition to industrial or manufacturing plants.

Financing under the local development corporation is limited to a lending institution first mortgage equal to fifty percent of the appraised value of the property plus a job development authority second mortgage equal to thirty percent of said value. An industrial development agency is authorized to finance any of its projects up to one hundred percent of its value.

The establishment of the Town of Hempstead Industrial Development Agency is necessary in order to further actively promote, attract, encourage and develop economically sound commerce and industry within the Town of Hempstead for the purpose of preventing unemployment and economic deterioration and to further advance the job opportunities, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the Town of Hempstead.
