4. If the Applicant is unable to obtain financial assistance from the Agency for the project, what would be the impact on the Applicant and on the municipality?

The proposed 33-unit workforce housing project located in the Baldwin Urban Renewal Area would be infeasible. The community and prospective residents would forgo the benefit of approximately \$12 million of State and Federal resources, and the Town would lose out on much needed rental housing.

- 5. The Applicant understands and agrees that the provisions of Section 862(1) of the New York General Municipal Law, as provided below, will not be violated if financial assistance is provided for the proposed project:
